1. In accordance with reference A and F, based on the doctrinal foundations of reference B and in order to meet the requirements of reference C, the C-IED Centre of Excellence (C-IED CoE) conducts the DOMEX Course 24.1 from **08 to 19 APRIL 2024**, in Spain.

Course Code (ETOC): IED-ED-35665.

2. The course aims to enhance Technical Exploitation capabilities focused in DOMEX discipline, including Document Exploitation (DOCEX), Media Exploitation (MEDEX), Cellular Phone Exploitation (CELLEX) and UAS Exploitation. The framework will be initial collection capabilities and the use of elementary tools and software to extract information at the tactical level for integration into the Technical Exploitation system (level 2).
3. Representatives of the C-IED CoE sponsoring nations, NATO and Australia, Austria, Ireland, New Zealand, Sweden and Switzerland are invited to attend DOMEX 24.1 which will be conducted in the **C-IED CoE premises in Hoyo de Manzanares and other location to be determined, both in Spain**. This second location will be indicated in proper time only to admitted applicants to the course.
4. The course has in total **12 seats** for attendees. 2 seats will be granted in priority for Law Enforcement personnel. Authority for prioritization is the C-IED CoE.

5. The deadline for application is **08 MARCH 2024**. Applications after the deadline will not be accepted.
6. If nations request more than one attendant for the course, they are kindly asked to prioritize the applicants.
7. All applicants will receive the confirmation/regret mail from C-IED CoE not later than 11 MARCH 2024. Selected participants can purchase the flight tickets after this mail. No travel arrangements should be made prior to receiving the confirmation of participation.
8. Details regarding real life support, COVID-19 restrictions, travel, accommodation, transportation, and meals, will be defined in the confirmation email.

ANNEX A:
COURSE DETAILS

1. Training Audience

a. Fields and levels of expertise:

The course will cover the following learning objectives:

- i. Trends regarding Technical Exploitation.
- ii. Technical Exploitation Processes.
- iii. Document & Media Exploitation (DOMEX) Outcomes and their potential contribution to Attack the Networks (AtN).
- iv. Document Exploitation (DOCEX) Capabilities.
- v. Media Exploitation (MEDEX) Capabilities (including UAS).
- vi. Cellular Phone Exploitation (CELLEX) Capabilities.
- vii. DOMEX Collection Techniques in Support to Field Exploitation Team/Weapon Intelligence Team (FET/WIT) processes.

Expected attendees are trained International or National FET/WIT or equivalent trained personnel (i.e.: Military Police, Military Search, Technical Exploitation Operations) and Intel/Ops Staff, involved in technical exploitation.

It is highly recommended for the participants who are not familiar with the C-IED environment the attendance to the WIT Course in advance, highly recommended but not mandatory.

b. Military Ranks:

Officers (OF-1 to OF-4) and Non-Commissioned Officers (OR-3 to OR-9) and equivalent ranks of Law Enforcement and Intelligence Agencies.

c. Language proficiency

An adequate understanding of written and spoken English is required. In accordance with STANAG 6001, 2.2.2.2 level is recommended for students to attend this course.

2. Tentative Agenda

The DOMEX course lasts two weeks. The first week focuses on theoretical understanding and practical application of several forensic procedures in preparation for the second practical week. The first week is spent learning about the Technical Exploitation strategy and capabilities, as well as being acquainted with the forensics tools used throughout the course. The second week includes a scenario in which students must use what they've learned to exploit multiple situations.

The closing day will end promptly at 14:00.

3. Coordinating Instructions

- i. Dates and Duty Hours: 0830-1700 Mon to Fri. Timings can be extended if needed.
- ii. Students must be prepared to undertake various tactical tasks, situations, and other scenarios, as the instruction requires, during the practical exercises.

4. Miscellaneous

This course is the first edition for 2024. A second iteration is scheduled to be delivered in the second semester of 2024.
