1. NATO Nations, Australia, Austria, Ireland, Israel, Japan, New Zealand, Republic of Korea, Switzerland and Ukraine are kindly informed that the 25.2 iteration of the Document & Media Collection and Processing in Support to Attack the Networks Course will be conducted in Spain from **27 October – 14 November 2025**.
2. The aim of the course is to enhance Technical Exploitation capabilities focused in DOMEX, including Document Exploitation (DOCEX), Media Exploitation (MEDEX), Cellular Phone Exploitation (CELLEX), and their application over Unmanned System (UxS).
3. The DOMEX Course will be comprised of two independent phases, focused on specific personnel needs:
 - a. **Operator Phase** (2 weeks): Focused on tactical collection, secure handling of digital media, chain of custody procedures and field exploitation skills (including the acquisition of data). This phase certifies operators to process seized devices rapidly and effectively under operational conditions, following evidentiary standards.

- b. **Analyst Phase** (1 week): This module trains participants in interpreting DOMEX outputs by using specific digital forensic tools, correlating them with other sources.
4. The framework will be collection capabilities and the use of tools, digital forensic tools and software to extract information at the tactical level for integration into the Technical Exploitation system (level 2).
5. The expected target audience are trained International or National FET/WIT or equivalent trained personnel (i.e.: Military Police, Military Search, Military Intelligence, Special Forces) and Intel/Ops Staff, involved in technical exploitation. The military ranks range from OR-3 to OR-9 and from OF-1 to OF-4 and equivalent ranks of Law Enforcement and Intelligence Agencies. Previous knowledge on the use of extraction tools for electronic devices is not mandatory.
6. The official Calling Letter of the course will be released not later than **15 July 2025**.
