
The Weapons Intelligence Team (WIT) course 24.2 was organized by the NATO C-IED CoE in Hungary

The second iteration of the NATO Weapons Intelligence Team (WIT) Course 2024 took place between 10 and 27 September in Szentendre, Hungary, with 22 attendees from 12 nationalities.

The course was hosted by the Hungarian Defence Forces NCO Academy, as part of the VNCF WIT Training 2024/25 Executing Agent Agreement.

For 3 weeks, the course covered the C-IED Exploitation Level 1 capability, including make-up and type of IEDs, forensics, photography, terrorist tactical design, s-UAS exploitation, DOMEX basic concepts and skills and post blast collection and analysis.

The course also included a very complete practical phase, through which the instructors supported the development of skills needed for the future WIT operators.

For the participating nations, this type of course is an excellent opportunity to understand the NATO exploitation process and to train WIT operators, enhancing their national WIT capability building process.

C-IED CoE continues to support nations and partners in their national capability building process, ensuring the coherence of the Alliance.
