 - c. Facilitate and enhance interaction in the multinational C-IED Community of Interest (CoI): "Information exchange out of theatre" find the gap of the CIED LL community info sharing.
- 6. As the IED threat is global with networks exceeding national borders, this LLWS is an appropriate opportunity for the community of interest to share and provide
