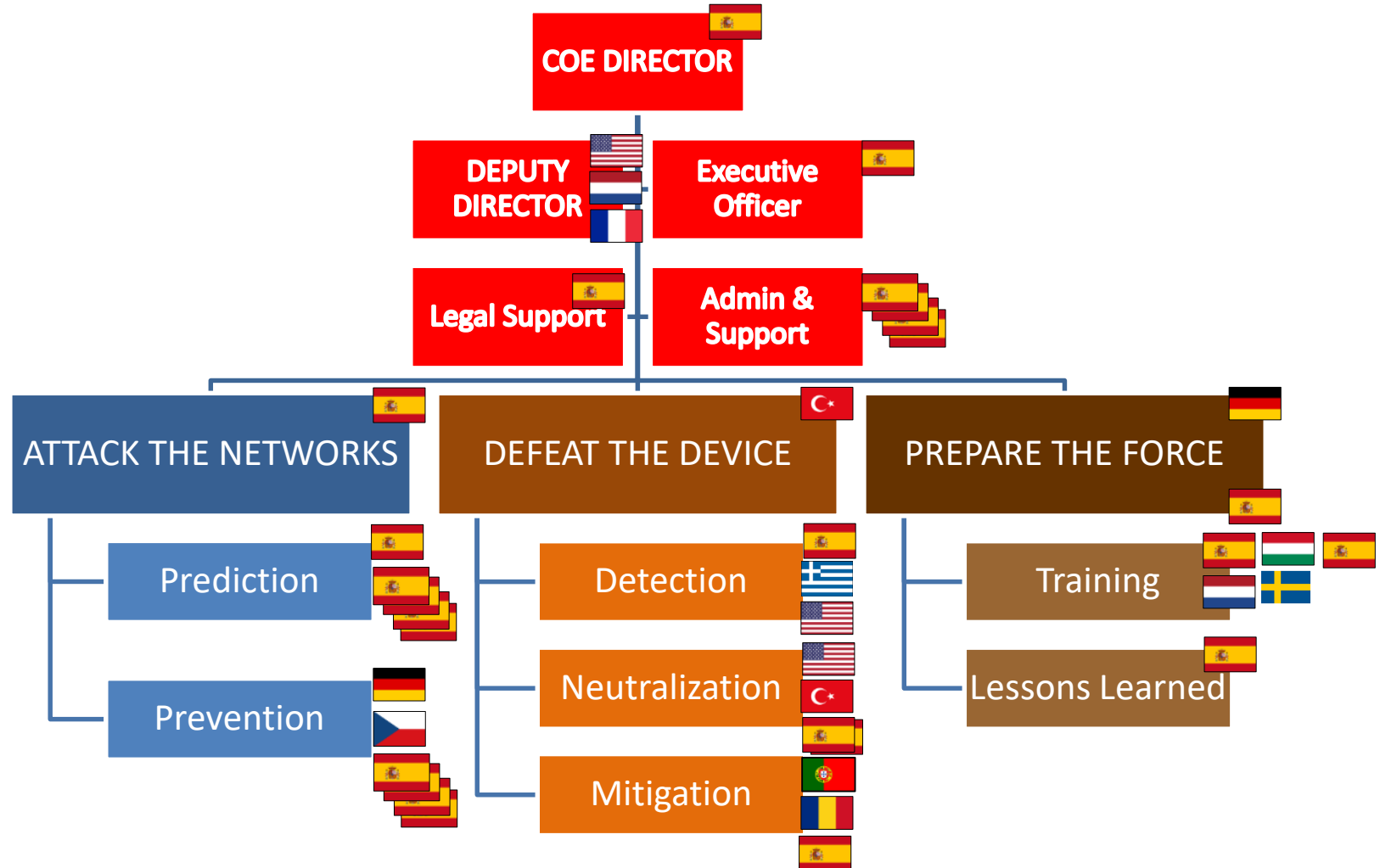

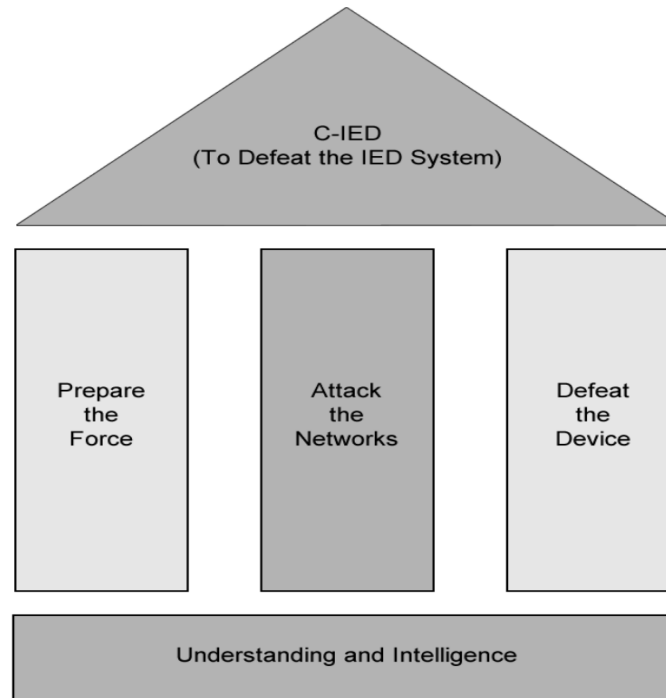




# What is C-IED?



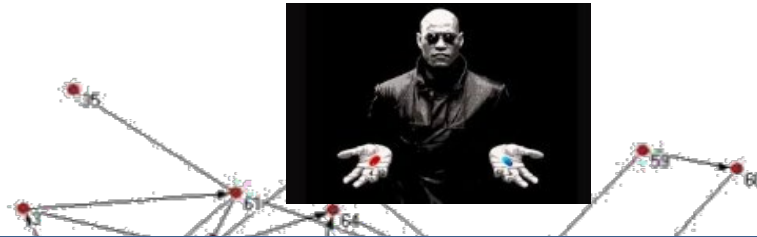
**Improvised Explosive Device System**: Personnel, resources and activities necessary to resource, plan, execute and exploit an improvised explosive device event.



## ***Countering-Improvised Explosive Device***

The **COLLECTIVE** efforts at **ALL LEVELS** to defeat the **IED SYSTEM** by attacking the networks, defeating the device, and preparing the force.

C-IED crosses military functional areas and relies upon an **integrated and comprehensive approach** that is **joint, inter-agency and multinational**. This should be accomplished through permanent and intensive civil-military interaction.
