3. All meetings subject to this calling notice are open to NATO Nations and NATO bodies. There will be no partner participation. Participation by VTC will not be possible.

4. Recipients of this calling notice are not expected to attend every meeting. However, NBEWG and NTEG members, as well as members of the NBPCG, are highly encouraged to take this opportunity for mutual situational awareness by attending each other's meetings and by participating in the Joint Icebreaker/Informal Table Top Exercise.
5. NTEG and NBEWG members are invited to contact the group secretaries in order to offer additional briefings to those proposed on the respective agendas at annex.
6. The NBEWG Data Team and NTEG Martial Vision Subgroup meetings are intended for those specialized memberships, rather than a general audience, although new members are welcome.

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7. The Joint Icebreaker/Informal Table Top Exercise on Tuesday evening is intended for all participants. A traditional icebreaker will be augmented by an informal, but highly structured, team-based, role-playing TTX featuring tactical through strategic Technical Exploitation, Battlefield Evidence and Biometrics play in simulated, but realistic, joint force operating in a multi-domain deterrence and defence scenario. The TTX will promote interaction amongst participants, joint problem solving and a shared understanding of the challenges and benefits of a robust NATO TE, BE and Biometrics framework. Please note that a €30 euro conference fee will be requested to support the icebreaker/TTX – please **bring cash.**

### 1. Registration

All the applicants will receive a confirmation or regret notification from C-IED COE to their e-mail addresses NLT 31 March 2026.

Due to capacity restrictions, delegations of greater than 2 per nation/organization should indicate priority in the unlikely case we will have to restrict participation due to over booking.

### 2. Security

As the meeting sessions will take place at Class II facilities, all participants must possess a Security Clearance to attend.

Participants for the event are required to bring their NATO S\*\*\*\*\* Security clearance or National Equivalent certificate during the in-processing. Applicants shall also send their Security Clearance Certificate in advance as an attachment to the PAF to [NATOBETE@ciedcoe.org](mailto:NATOBETE@ciedcoe.org), Cc. Without a NATO S\*\*\*\*\* certificate, the access to Class I/II areas in which the meetings will take place will not be authorized.

To access the C-IED COE facilities all participants are obliged to physically bring the same ID as indicated inside the PAF they sent.

Electronic devices (e.g. laptops, memory sticks, mobile phones...), recorders and cameras are not allowed to enter inside Class I/II areas: the C-IED COE has enough lockers for safe storage of mobile phones/other devices during meetings.

Participants should make their own reservations to the hotels, but daily transportation will be provided from/to those recommended hotels to/from C-IED COE. Please indicate your accommodation in the PAF and request for that daily transportation from/to the recommended hotels.

### 4. Food and drinks

Vending machines are available at C-IED COE facilities.

Lunch is non-hosted: however, lunch can be taken at the Base Mess Hall (Army Engineer Academy military base) but must be paid **in cash** during in-processing by the individual (7.29 € per day taking lunch). Every attendee is requested to indicate in the PAF whether they wish to include lunch.

During the afternoon of Day-2, 28 April, a non-hosted icebreaker/informal table top exercise will be offered to foster and strengthen relationships among attendees: the payment for the icebreaking event (30€) **must be paid in cash** during in-processing. Please indicate if you are going to attend the icebreaker/TTX in the PAF.

### 5. Transportation

The nearest international airport to C-IED COE is Madrid Adolfo Suarez Barajas.

In the aim of planning your transportation, we recommend you use the mobile APP “MOOVIT” in your mobile phone: it works perfectly for planning transportation in Madrid province by different means (e.g. train, cercanias, bus, taxi, Uber...).

Moving from the Airport to the C-IED COE or Torrelodones, it is possible to take the underground train (*Metro*) from all airport terminals (Line 8), transfer at “*Nuevos Ministerios*” Station with Line 6 and get off at “*Moncloa*” station; then, in the same intermodal transportation hub (level 1, island 2 walkway 28) take the bus 611/611A line directly to Army Engineers’ School (40 minutes) or 613 lines directly to the hotel PAX Torrelodones (20 minutes).

The recommended hotels in Las Rozas are directly accessible through City Train (“*Cercanias*”) from Terminal 4: take Line C1, transfer in “*Chamartin*” station, and then you could take Line C10 direction “*Villalba de Guadarrama*” stopping at “*Las Rozas*” station.

If you would prefer to take a taxi from the airport to Torrelodones or C-IED COE, the price should be around 70-80 €.
